In the wake of President Trump's comments on Gaza, The Islamic Council of Queensland (ICQ) calls on the Australian government to take a moral stand

President Trump's ill-advised, ill-considered, genocide-enabling comments will lead to more displacement of people and loss of life." Said Mr Khan.

Trump's belligerent words now make clear that the war that America has been losing in Gaza over the past 15 months will lead to more financial losses as well as more losses in Palestinian and Israeli lives. Australia should have no part in that. Please, Ms Wong and Mr Albanese, if you're not going to be on the side of the victims who are defending their land against the Israeli occupiers, then stay out of this disastrous war."
