Position Type: Voluntary

Term Length: 1 year (renewable)

Role Purpose:

The Student/Youth Delegates (one male, one female) serve as non-voting members of the Islamic Council of Queensland (ICQ) Executive Committee. Their primary role is to represent the views, needs, and aspirations of Muslim students and youth across Queensland. These delegates act as a bridge between ICQ and the broader youth and student community, ensuring meaningful engagement and participation of young Muslims in community development, advocacy, and representation at a state level.

Key Responsibilities:

• Representation & Advocacy

- Act as key representatives for Queensland's Muslim students and youth,
 bringing their concerns, ideas, and priorities to the ICQ Executive Committee.
- Provide input into ICQ's youth and education-related policies, initiatives, and programs.

• Community Engagement

- o Facilitate two-way communication between ICQ and Muslim students/youth, ensuring their voices are heard in decision-making processes.
- Engage with student associations, youth groups, and relevant stakeholders to promote collaboration and unity.

• Information Dissemination

- Help share and promote ICQ's positions, statements, and initiatives within the youth and student community.
- Use social media, student networks, and community platforms to amplify ICQ's work.

• Conference Planning Support

- Assist ICQ in the planning and coordination of an **Australasia and Southeast Asian Muslim Student/Youth Conference**.
- o Contribute youth-specific perspectives and logistical support to ensure the event is inclusive, impactful, and engaging.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Must identify as Muslim and reside in Queensland.
- Be aged between 18–30 years.
- Currently enrolled in a tertiary education institution or actively involved in a recognised youth/student organisation.
- Demonstrated leadership, communication, and organisational skills.
- Commitment to the values and objectives of the Islamic Council of Queensland.

Additional Information:

- This is a non-voting position but includes full participation in discussions and working groups.
- Delegates will be expected to attend ICQ Executive Committee meetings regularly and contribute meaningfully to all assigned tasks. Currently the ICQ Exco meets every two months.
